

Hospitality guide for Friday night gatherings March 15, 7:00 – 8:30pm

Friday night gatherings are a new way to gather during ACC Assembly weekend. At gatherings, members of various ACC congregations who live nearby will be connected into a small group to gather, watch the Friday session virtually, and discuss afterward using provided discussion questions. This is an opportunity to meet those in your neighborhood who attend other ACC congregations.

For these gatherings we are seeking 10-12 hosts to provide a space and hospitality for 5-10 people.

Things we'd ask hosts to provide:

- Parking and sitting space for 5-10 people
- Dessert or snacks to enjoy during or after the session
- Bathroom access during the gathering
- A TV and the ability to connect a laptop to display a Zoom meeting (don't worry, we'll help with this!)
- Lead a conversation on the theme using provided discussion questions
- Address and directions to the house that can be shared with invitees

Things ACC will provide to hosts:

- Instructions, support and any hardware you would need to share a Zoom webinar on your TV (you can do this!). This would include a time to test the process before gathering time.
- Discussion questions for the gathering
- A list of guests attending
- If needed, recipes for ACC staff members' favorite desserts
