Living Into Welcome: Hospitality and Inclusion for our LGBTQ+ neighbors
As a faith community, we are committed to providing care and hospitality to our LGBTQ+ neighbors, and many among us are actively discerning what that looks like in practice. This workshop draws on the experience of North Baltimore Mennonite Church and their meaningful work in creating authentic welcome for the LGBTQ+ community, and invites reflection on Atlantic Coast Conference's own history with inclusion. We'll explore together what our congregations and conference are doing, what more might be possible, and what faithful hospitality looks like for us moving forward. Mennonite Church USA's 2022 Resolution for Repentance and Transformation provides helpful backdrop for this conversation as we discern our shared path ahead.

Grounded and Present: Anabaptist Perspectives on Welcoming Immigrants in Uncertain Times
Description: This workshop brings together voices from those actively engaged in immigration work, sharing stories of welcome, safety, and community support from organizations and individuals on the front lines. Participants will hear firsthand accounts of local and national efforts, including experiences with ICE

encounters and community preparedness, and will explore practical ways to get involved. Drawing on Anabaptist values and faith convictions, the workshop also creates space for honest conversation about staying hopeful and balanced amid anxiety and uncertainty — including for those who may feel hesitant about protest or direct action. Whether you are deeply engaged or just beginning to discern your role, this workshop offers both inspiration and grounding for the road ahead.
